DROUGHT UPDATE

Due to the continued drought in California, the Board of Directors is considering the adoption of a water conservation ordinance. A public meeting has been scheduled for 9:00 A.M. on 4/30/22 to hear public comments on the proposed ordinance. The adoption of a water conservation ordinance will enable the Board to place restrictions on water certain water uses to ensure an adequate supply of water for domestic use. The adoption of a water conservation ordinance is also expected to delay or eliminate any need for the Board to declare a water shortage emergency which could entail more drastic water use restrictions.
